- A plan that disseminates Beppu's charm both outside of the city and in foreign countries, and holds potential for new businesses
- Someone from outside Beppu City requesting assistance for the tasks/problems that exist in their area

Review Method


The judging will be conducted based on the initial screening of the entry sheet, the secondary screening by interview, and the presentations on the day of the ONE BEPPU DREAM AWARD 2019 event.

The presentation on the day of the ONE BEPPU DREAM AWARD 2019 event, and the responses to questions regarding the presentation, will also be subject to review by about 100 companies involved in businesses in Beppu.

About the Award and Prize Money

The prize for the ONE BEPPU DREAM AWARD will only be awarded to one person. In terms of the funding, the finalists' business plans which have passed the secondary screening will be fairly scrutinized in prior by the judges and the secretariat, then an appropriate amount of investment will be offered to each plan. On the day of the AWARD event, if the judges and the secretariat offer the fund over the amount of investment which was offered before, that amount of fund will be provided to the finalists at a later day through the cloud funding.

- 1. We will contact people individually with the information regarding secondary screenings.
- 2. Presentation materials are required to be submitted for the secondary screenings.
- 3. The application form that you have submitted may be reviewed by the judges and officials in the secretariat during the screening and the matching processes.
- 4. Please note that we cannot give information about any results of the screenings.
- 5. We will not review any plans judged to be inappropriate from the viewpoint of public order and morals.

In principle, secondary screening will take place in person in Beppu City, but those from remote towns or those who are overseas residents may do remote interviews.

Post-Selection

Prior to the issuance of funds, you must submit a written oath.

As examples of how the funds may be used, we have prepared the following list, but please consult the executive office when using the funds for any other purposes.

- 1) Research costs
- 2) Advertisement expenses, PR expenses

3) Personnel/labour expenses, supplies expenses, telecommunication/shipping expenses, rent, travel expenses, utility expenses, printing expenses, document purchase expenses

4) Expenses required for purchase and repair of equipment, tools etc. necessary for establishing the business

- 5) Expenses required to acquire the right to use the program
- 6) Raw material costs necessary for promoting the business
- 7) Outsourcing costs

Please note that we may ask you to return some or all of the funds in the following situations:

1) When you do not fulfil the reporting obligation (Performance Report, Accounting Report) regarding entrepreneurial activity

- 2) When entrepreneurial activities are interrupted due to injury or other health reasons
- 3) When the execution of the intended entrepreneurial plan is significantly delayed
- 4) When activities are judged to be significantly in contrast to the original plan
